Variance for Helene Toporowych

Councilman Divis – Stated the Planning Committee of Council met on Monday, February 4, 2019, to discuss the Notice of Proposal to Vary for the Applicant Helene Toporowych, 2107 Lorimer Rd., Parma. PPN 445-32-053.

The request is for an "USE" Variance of the City of Parma Codified Ordinances of <u>Section</u> <u>1153.02 – SINGLE FAMILY HOUSE DISTRICTS-PRINCIPAL USES AND BUILDINGS</u>. The proposal is to allow for rebuilding of existing 2-family home at 2107 Lorimer Rd that is in SingleFamily Zoning if destroyed. Code requires that within any Single-Family House District no building or premises shall be erected, used, arranged or designed to be used, in whole or in part, for other than single-family detached dwellings. This variance would result in allowing for rebuilding of 2-family residence in Single-Family Zoning District. It was also recommended that this be recorded on the deed at the Recorder's Office.
