Mr. Brennan – Stated you have before you the minutes from the Regular Council
Meetings held on June 17, 2013 and July 1, 2013 and from the Tax Budget Hearing held
on July 1, 2013. Asked if there were any additions or corrections to these minutes?
Hearing none, the minutes will stand approved as printed.

COMMUNICATIONS, PETITIONS AND CLAIMS

Councilman Divis - Stated the Planning Committee of Council met to discuss the
Notice of Proposal to Vary for the Applicant Lon C. Marino, Lancaster Lands, LP, aka
Clover Construction Management, Inc. 4191 Alicia Trail, Stow, OH 44224. PPN is 441-39-
001. The first request is for an "Area" variance of the City of Section 1159.04(e) -
MULTI-FAMILY DISTRICTS – SUPPLEMENTAL REGULATIONS – SIZE LIMITATIONS. The
proposal is building new 3-story, 125 unit independent senior living apartments at
Stumph & Huffman Roads. Maximum of 10 apartment units permitted on ground level in
multi-family developments. The proposal is 40 units on ground level. This variance
would result in allowing 30 more units on ground level of multi-family development. The
second request is for an "Area" variance of Section 1159.03(b) MULTI-FAMILY
DISTRICTS – ACCESSORY USES AND BUILDINGS. Accessory services in multi-family
dwellings for more than 400 families may be permitted. The Applicant is proposing
accessory service of beauty salon in multi-family dwelling with only 125 units. This
variance would result in allowing for accessory service in multi-family dwelling with 12
units. The third request "Area" variance of Section 1187.04(b) – AREA REGULATIONS –
LANDSCAPED AREAS AND LOT COVERAGE FOR MULTI-FAMILY DISTRICTS. Not more
than 15% of the area of any lot, parcel or site upon which any apartment house building

is situated shall be covered with buildings. The Applicant is proposing lot coverage of 17%. This variance would result in allow 2% more lot coverage than Code allows. The fourth request is for an "Area" variance of Section 1193.03(b) – SIDE YARDS – MULTI-FAMILY DISTRICTS – MINIMUM DISTANCE BETWEEN BUILDINGS AND SIDE OR REAR LOT LINES. Code requires rear setback of 102 feet. The proposed rear setback is 76'. This variance would result in 26' less rear setback. The fifth request is for an "Area" variance of the City of Parma Codified Ordinances of Section 1197.05(3) – OFF STREET PARKING AND LOADING FACILITIES – SCHEDULE OF REQUIRED PARKING. Parking shall be provided at a rate of 2 spaces per dwelling unit for a total of 250 spaces. The proposal is for 125 spaces. This variance would result in 125 less parking spaces. There is a stipulation of the feasibility of installing an additional ingress/egress apron on Huffman Rd.

Motion made by Councilman Divis seconded by Councilman Day to grant the above Variances with the stipulation as recommended by the Parma Board of Zoning Appeals and the Planning Committee of Council. Motion carried.

Councilman Divis - Stated the Planning Committee of Council met to discuss the Notice of Proposal to Vary for the Applicant Dale Guenther, Building Design, Inc. 2062 Stone Ridge Dr., Hinckley, OH 44233 for property on Liberty Avenue. PPN is 442-17-091. The Request is for a "Use" variance of the Section 1153.02 – SINGLE-FAMILY HOUSE DISTRICTS – PRINCIPAL USES AND BUILDINGS. Within any Single-Family House District, no building or premises shall be erected, used, arranged or designed to be used, in whole or in part, for other than single-family detached dwellings. The proposal is to use parcel zoned Single-Family B1 as commercial parking lot on Liberty Avenue. This variance would allow use of parcel in Single-Family zoning district as commercial parking lot. There is a Stipulation that the Applicant is to immediately take care of the standing water and remove the top soil. By granting this variance the property owner's predicament cannot be obviated through any other method other than a variance. Additionally, to continue moving this process forward Mrs. Morrow suggested that the Applicant bring in the plans for the parking lot from his engineer by August 5 for the August Planning Commission meeting.

Motion made by Councilman Divis seconded by Councilman Day to Grant the Variance with the Stipulation as recommended by the Parma Board of Zoning Appeals and the Planning Committee of Council. Motion carried.

Councilman Divis – Stated the Planning Committee of Council met to consider The Notice of Proposal to Vary for the applicant Dave Mason, 6102 Bradley, Parma, OH 44129. PPN 444-02-007 & 009. The request is for an "Area" variance of Section 1187.01(a) –AREA REGULATIONS – AREA DISTRICT REGULATIONS. The proposal is to create two parcels for single- family homes at S/L 14a & S/L 14c Goans Place. Minimum lot size required by Code with sanitary sewer (Zoning SF B1): 60' wide x 130' deep and 7,800 sq. ft. in area. The proposed lot depth for S/L a: 63.50' x 120.47' on southern boundary line and proposed lot depth for S/L c: 60' x 115.81' on southern boundary line. This variance would result in 9.53' less lot depth for S/L 14a and 14.19' less lot depth on S/L 14c.

Motion made by Councilman Divis seconded by Councilman Day to grant the Variance as recommended by the Parma Board of Zoning Appeals and the Planning Committee of Council. Motion carried.
