Safety Director Weinreich – With respect to item 1, this is for the approved purchase of the K-9 vehicle that Council acted on late last year. The Police Department anticipated that the purchase would be completed in 2016. It was not and they errored in not requesting an adjustment to the temporary appropriations.

Councilman Crossman – Asked what they were expecting to pay for the K-9 vehicle?

Mr. Safety Director of the vehicle is approximately \$6,000 to \$8,000 to convert it to use.

Councilman Crossman – Asked why they need a \$70,000 appropriation? Safety Director Weinreich - Stated that the Chief included the amount he anticipates for the whole year to be spent out of the line item.

Auditor Day - Stated with that fund, there was a carry over balance of over \$190,000. So, there is plenty of available resources in the D.A.R.E. Fund.

Councilwoman Lime - Asked if we are still collecting funds for the D.A.R.E. Fund? Auditor Day – Stated that they are still collecting funds on those accounts. Motion made by Councilwoman Lime seconded by Councilman Casselberry to
