The Parma Civil Service Commission will conduct the written exam for Firefighter for the City of Parma to establish an eligible list. Said exam will be held on August 22, 2020. Applications are available August 3, 2020 through August 20, 2020. The City of Parma is an Equal Opportunity Employer and strongly encourages minorities to apply. Applications and further information obtainable at the Civil Service Office located in Memorial Hall directly behind Parma City Hall, 6617 Ridge Rd. Parma (access off Ridgewood Dr.) 440-885-8060. Completed applications must be returned to the Parma Civil Service Office, 6617 Ridge Rd. Parma, Ohio. Deadline for filing is August 20, 2020.

Some qualifications needed to apply are: Applicant must be 18 yrs. old; must have Ohio Emergency Medical Technician Certificate EMT-P (Paramedic); must have Firefighter Level II by time of appointment; must be high school graduate or have GED certificate; must have valid Ohio Driver's license. Applicants will be required to pass a written exam, agility exam, background check, pre-employment polygraph, physical exam, post employment polygraph exam, and psychological exam. There is a \$30.00 non-refundable fee to take the written exam. Said fee to be paid at time of filing application. Said fee will be waived with proof of financial hardship. Individuals must pass written exam and agility exam, there will be an additional \$60.00 non-refundable fee for the Tri-C Agility exam. Candidates must register directly with Tri-C.
