AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SERVICE TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH THE CITY OF PARMA HEIGHTS AND THE LOWEST AND BEST BIDDER FOR THE PURCHASE OF ASPHALT CONCRETE, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PARMA, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the Director of Public Service is hereby authorized to enter into contract with the City of Parma Heights and _____, the lowest and best bidder, for the purchase of asphalt concrete, at the bid price of \$ _____, except for contract modifications pursuant to the requirements of Ohio Revised Code §735.07.

Section 2. That the Director of Public Service is hereby authorized to execute said contract and to take such action and to execute such other documents and amendments thereto as may be necessary as are approved by the Law Director.

Section 3. That funds for said purchase shall be paid from Fund Nos. 001-022-Recreation; 001-028-Public Lands & Bldgs.; 229-229-CDBG; 275-275-Sewer; 276-276-Streets; 277-277-St. Hwy. 7-1/2%; 278-278-Muni. Motor Tax; 405-405-Capital Improvement; and 520-520-Golf Course; Account No. 61014-06216-Operating Supplies.

Section 4. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council; and that all deliberations of the Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements.

Section 5. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare of the City of Parma, and for the further reason that this measure is necessary in order to purchase the material for the upcoming 2016 paving season, and this Ordinance shall become immediately effective upon receiving the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all members elected to Council and approval of the Mayor, otherwise from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
