

ORDINANCE NO. 199-12

AN ORDINANCE TO ACCEPT THE MONETARY DONATION FROM THE VETERAN'S ADMINISTRATION FOR AN AUDIBLE CROSSWALK TO BE LOCATED APPROXIMATELY ONE HUNDRED (100) FEET WEST OF 8787 BROOKPARK ROAD, IN THE CITY OF PARMA, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PARMA, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That this Council and Administration of the City of Parma hereby accept the monetary donation in the amount of \$1,186.00 from the Veteran's Administration for an audible crosswalk to be located approximately one hundred (100) feet west of 8787 Brookpark Road in the City of Parma.

Section 2. That the Director of Public Safety is hereby authorized to enter into an Audible Crosswalk Agreement between the City of Parma and the City of Brooklyn, with a copy in substantially similar form attached as Exhibit "A".

Section 3. That said donation shall be deposited into Fund No. 001-013-Traffic Lighting, Account No. 48136-00000-Donations.

Section 4. That funds for said purchase and installation of audible crosswalk shall be paid from Fund No. 001-013-Traffic Lighting, Account No. 61014-00000-Operating Supplies.

Section 5. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of the Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements.

Section 6. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare of the City of Parma, and for the further reason that this measure is necessary in order for the audible pedestrian signal to be installed in the near future, and this Ordinance shall become immediately effective upon receiving the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all members elected to Council and approval of the Mayor, otherwise from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
