

AUDIBLE CROSSWALK AGREEMENT
Between
The City of Parma
And
The City of Brooklyn

Purpose: The Veteran's Administration (VA) located at 8787 Brookpark Road, Parma, Ohio, desires to have an audible crosswalk. The City of Parma (Parma) and City of Brooklyn (Brooklyn) have determined that said audible crosswalk would be in the public's interest. This Agreement states the obligations of each City.

Parma and Brooklyn hereby agree to the following:

- (1) The crosswalk shall remain in its present location:

The signal is located approximately one hundred (100) feet west of 8787 Brookpark Road.
- (2) The audible crosswalk shall have the specifications stated in attached document "A".
- (3) The City of Parma shall be responsible for the following:

Purchasing and installing all equipment necessary to upgrade the existing crosswalk.
- (4) The City of Brooklyn shall be responsible for the following:

Compensating Signal Service for making the final connection and activating the audible crosswalk.

Maintenance of all property associated with the audible crosswalk including but not limited to equipment purchased and installed by Parma.

Insuring that said audible crosswalk is operable unless and until the VA and Parma request that the audible crosswalk be removed.
- (5) Upon the completion of the construction of the audible crosswalk all of the equipment directly related to the audible crosswalk shall be owed by Brooklyn.

- (7) Both parties agree to execute any and all documents, including but not limited to easements, consistent with this Agreement. Both parties agree to work together in order to satisfy the VA. The parties shall notify each other of any problems and agree to address said problems in a timely fashion. In the event the problems are not corrected to the aggrieved parties' satisfaction, it shall notify the other party in writing of its dissatisfaction and allow the other party 10 days to respond to the written notice. Neither party shall commence to take legal action until said 10 day time period has passed and further notifying the other party that it will be commencing said action.
