

ORDINANCE NO. 153-13

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SERVICE TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT FOR PROFESSIONAL DESIGN SERVICES FOR HEADWALL REPAIR/REPLACEMENT ON AUGUSTINE DRIVE, MEADOW LANE, THORNCLIFFE DRIVE, AND GETTYSBURG DRIVE IN THE CITY OF PARMA, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PARMA, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the Mayor and the Director of Public Service are hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Donald G. Bohning & Associates, Inc., for professional design services for headwall repair/replacement at 2207/2213 Augustine Drive, 2325/2331 Augustine Drive, 7423/7427 Meadow Lane, 7104/7121 Thorncliffe Drive and 1760/1800 Gettysburg Drive in the City of Parma at a cost not to exceed \$90,550.00, with a copy of the engineering service proposal attached as Exhibit "A".

Section 2. That the Mayor and the Director of Public Service are hereby authorized to execute said contract and to take such action and to execute such other documents and amendments thereto as may be necessary as are approved by the Law Director.

Section 3. That funds for said services shall be paid from Fund No. 405-405-Capital Improvements; Account No. 62110-15313-Professional Services.

Section 4. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council; and that all deliberations of the Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements.

Section 5. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare of the City of Parma, and for the further reason that this service is necessary due to the erosion from defective headwall endangering properties, and this Ordinance shall become immediately effective upon receiving the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all members elected to Council and approval of the Mayor, otherwise from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
