AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND A PORTION OF THE EXHIBIT
“A” OF ORDINANCE NO. 295-05 TO ACCEPT A REVISED
AMOUNT FOR A CONTRACT WITH GPD ASSOCIATES FOR
THE SPRAGUE ROAD/HOERTZ SANITARY SEWER
PROJECT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PARMA, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the portion of the proposal fees on Exhibit “A” of Ordinance No. 295-05, passed December 12, 2005, and amended by Ordinance No. 314-11, passed December 19, 2011, and Ordinance No. 8-12, passed January 17, 2012, which presently reads as follows:

“Not to exceed cost: \$83,305.17”

is hereby amended to read as follows:

“Not to exceed cost : **\$93,553.63**”

Section 2. That only that portion of the proposal fees of Exhibit “A” of Ordinance No. 295-05, passed December 12, 2005, and amended by Ordinance No. 314-11, passed December 19, 2011, and Ordinance No. 8-12, passed January 17, 2012, as it existed heretofore, is hereby repealed.

Section 3. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements.

Section 4. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety, and welfare of the City of Parma, and for the further reason that this measure is necessary in order to pay for additional services related to the sanitary sewer project, and this Ordinance shall become immediately effective upon receiving the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all members elected to Council and approval of the Mayor, otherwise from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
