AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SAFETY TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT UNDER THE STATE CONTRACT PRICING FOR THE CHASSIS REPAIRS TO MEDIC 4 FOR THE PARMA FIRE DEPARTMENT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PARMA, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the Director of Public Safety is hereby authorized to make payment to Horton Emergency Vehicles Company, under State of Ohio contract pricing, for chassis repairs to Medic 4 for the Parma Fire Department at a cost not to exceed \$126,231.00.

Section 2. That the Director of Public Safety is hereby authorized to take such action and execute documents and amendments thereto as may be necessary as are approved by the Law Director.

Section 3. That funds for said chassis repairs shall be paid from Fund Nos. 105-105-Fire Levy, 405-405-Capital Improvements, Account No. 61101-03813-Vehicle Maintenance Repairs.

Section 4. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements.

Section 5. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety, and welfare of the City of Parma, and for the further reason that this measure is necessary in order that these repairs can be done at the earliest possible date, and this Ordinance shall become immediately effective upon receiving the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all members elected to Council and approval of the Mayor, otherwise from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
