

ORDINANCE NO. 50-13

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SAFETY TO WAIVE THE REQUIRED FEE WITHIN THE PARMA CODIFIED ORDINANCES FOR ITINERANT VENDORS, AND ISSUING A ONE DAY PERMIT FOR VENDORS PARTICIPATING IN THE MAY 5, 2013, POLISH CONSTITUTION DAY PARADE, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Polish Congress, Ohio Division, celebrates its annual Polish Constitution Day Parade and Party the first Sunday of each May on Ridge Road in Parma; and,

WHEREAS, the City of Parma is active in organizing and supporting this community event; and,

WHEREAS, the City of Parma has secured the attendance of several area itinerant vendors to provide catering services to the attendees of the Parade on Sunday, May 5, 2013; and,

WHEREAS, requiring each itinerant vendor to pay a \$100.00 fee for a one day, four hour event would place an undue financial burden on the vendor and limit the City’s ability to attract food vendors for this event;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PARMA, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the Mayor and the Director of Public Safety are hereby authorized to waive the \$100.00 fee provision of Section 185.04(c) of the Parma Codified Ordinances and to modify the term of the itinerant vendor permit from thirty (30) days to one (1) day for itinerant vendors invited by the City of Parma to attend the Polish Constitution Day Parade on May 5, 2013.

Section 2. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council; and that all deliberations of the Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements.

Section 3. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare of the City of Parma, and for the further reason that this measure is necessary in order to issue one day permits for the May 5, 2013, event, and this Ordinance shall become immediately effective upon receiving the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all members elected to Council and approval of the Mayor, otherwise from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
