AN ORDINANCE TO REPEAL SECTION 131.05  
"FUNDING OF SURVEILLANCE OPERATIONS"  
OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF THE  
CITY OF PARMA, AND DECLARING AN  
EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PARMA, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That Section 131.05 "Funding of Surveillance Operations" of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Parma, which presently reads as follows:

“131.05 FUNDING OF SURVEILLANCE OPERATIONS.

No public moneys of the City may be expended to fund surveillance services or operations conducted by any private person or firm. This section shall not be construed to prohibit the employment of non-City persons or firms when authorized by the Chief of Police of the Fire Chief in conjunction with an on-going criminal investigation.”

**is hereby repealed in its entirety.**

Section 2. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of the Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements.

Section 3. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety, and welfare of the City of Parma, and for the further reason that this measure is necessary in order for this to be repealed in the near future, and this Ordinance shall become immediately effective upon receiving the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all members elected to Council and approval of the Mayor, otherwise from and after the earliest period allowed by Law.
