

RESOLUTION NO. 112-13

A RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE OHIO DIRECTOR OF TRANSPORTATION TO REDUCE THE SPEED LIMIT FROM 35 MILES PER HOUR TO 25 MILES HOUR ON BROADVIEW ROAD, BETWEEN SNOW ROAD AND BROOKPARK ROAD IN THE CITY OF PARMA, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, Ohio Revised Code Section 4511.21(l)(1) allows local authorities, by resolution, to request the Ohio Director of Transportation to determine and declare a reasonable and safe prima-facie speed limit for a particular street; and,

WHEREAS, the City of Parma Engineering Department has determined that more than fifty percent (50%) of the frontage on Broadview Road between successive intersections (between Snow Road and Brookpark Road) is occupied by buildings used for business; and,

WHEREAS, alternatively, the City of Parma Engineering Department has determined that fifty percent (50%) of the frontage of this portion of Broadview Road is occupied by buildings used for business and the character of the street is indicated by traffic control devices;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PARMA, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That this Council hereby requests the Ohio Director of Transportation to reduce the speed limit from 35 miles per hour to 25 miles per hour on Broadview Road, between Snow Road and Brookpark Road in the City of Parma.

Section 2. That the Clerk of Council is hereby directed to forward a true and accurate copy of this Resolution to the Ohio Director of Transportation.

Section 3. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements.

Section 4. That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare of the City of Parma, and for the further reason that this measure is necessary in order to request this change in the speed limit to the proper authority in a timely fashion, and this Resolution shall become immediately effective upon receiving the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all members elected to Council and approval of the Mayor, otherwise from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
