AN ORDINANCE TO MAKE APPROPRIATIONS FOR CURRENT EXPENSES AND EXPENDITURES OF THE CITY OF PARMA, OHIO, DURING THE PERIOD FROM JANUARY 1, 2015, TO AND INCLUDING DECEMBER 31, 2015, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PARMA, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That in order to provide for the current expenses and expenditures of the City of Parma during the period beginning January 1, 2015, and ending December 31, 2015, there is hereby appropriated from the General Fund the accounts and amounts set forth in Exhibit "A", attached hereto and incorporated herein as though fully and distinctly rewritten.

Section 2. That the Auditor of the City of Parma be, and he hereby is, authorized and directed to draw his warrants on the Treasurer of the City of Parma for the payment of any of the foregoing appropriations and upon receiving proper certificates and vouchers therefore, approved by the Board of Officials authorized by law to approve same, or an ordinance or resolution of Council to make the expenditures, provided further that the appropriation for contingencies can be expended only upon approval of two-thirds (2/3) vote of Council for items of expense constituting a legal obligation against the City for purposes other than those caused by specific appropriations herein made.

Section 3. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council; and that all deliberations of the Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements.

Section 4. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare of the City of Parma, and for the further reason that this measure is necessary to provide funds for the daily operation of City departments and the provision of City services, and this Ordinance shall become immediately effective upon receiving the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all members elected to Council and approval of the Mayor, otherwise from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
