AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND A PORTION OF EXHIBIT “A” OF ORDINANCE NO. 423-06 RELATIVE TO THE PART-TIME BASEBALL/SOFTBALL LEAGUE SUPERVISOR POSITION WITHIN THE DIVISION OF PARKS AND RECREATION, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the position of part-time Baseball Supervisor within the Division of Parks and Recreation was inadvertently removed from the part-time wage schedule on Ordinance No. 204-13, adopted on October 7, 2013, and it is necessary to now place this position back on the part-time wage schedule;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PARMA, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That Exhibit “A” of Ordinance No. 423-06, passed December 18, 2006, and most recently amended by Ordinance No. 204-13, is hereby amended to include the position of “Baseball/Softball League Supervisor” within the Division of Parks and Recreation, as shown on the exhibit attached hereto.

Section 2. That only that portion of Exhibit “A” of Ordinance No. 423-06, passed December 18, 2006, and most recently amended by Ordinance No. 204-13, as it existed heretofore, is hereby repealed.

Section 3. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council; and that all deliberations of the council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements.

Section 4. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare of the City of Parma, and for the further reason that this measure is necessary in order to make this amendment for the upcoming baseball/softball season, and this Ordinance shall become immediately effective upon receiving the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all members elected to Council and approval of the Mayor, otherwise from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
