AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SAFETY TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT THROUGH THE OHIO LAW ENFORCEMENT SUPPORT OFFICE (OHIO LESCO) OF THE OHIO DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY FOR THE PURCHASE OF ELEVEN (11) 2014 CHEVROLET IMPALA POLICE CARS, NINE (9) PATROL CARS AND TWO (2) DETECTIVE BUREAU CARS FOR THE PARMA POLICE DEPARTMENT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PARMA, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the Mayor and the Director of Public Safety are hereby authorized to enter into a contract through the Ohio Law Enforcement Support Office (Ohio LESCO) of the Ohio Department of Public Safety for the purchase of eleven (11) 2014 Chevrolet Impala Police Cars, nine (9) patrol cars and two (2) Detective Bureau cars for the Parma Police Department, at a cost not to exceed \$231,994.98.

Section 2. That the Mayor and the Director of Public Safety are hereby authorized to execute said contract and to take such action and to execute such other documents and amendments thereto as may be necessary as are approved by the Law Director.

Section 3. That funds for said purchase shall be paid from Fund Nos. 405-405-Capital Improvements; 104-104-Police; 162-162-OVI, and Account Nos. 68006-00011-Equipment and Facilities and 68006-00000-Equipment and Facilities.

Section 4. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements.

Section 5. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety, and welfare of the City of Parma, and for the further reason that this measure is necessary in order to make this purchase at the earliest possible date, and this Ordinance shall become immediately effective upon receiving the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all members elected to Council and approval of the Mayor, otherwise from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
