AN ORDINANCE TO ENTER INTO A SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF PARMA AND THE DEFENDANTS IN THE CASE KNOWN AS TERESA BRYANT, AS MOTHER, ETC. VS. POLICE OFFICER JAMES MANZO, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PARMA, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That a Settlement Agreement between the City of Parma and the Defendants in the case known as Teresa Bryant, as Mother, Etc. vs. Police Officer James Manzo, Case No. CV-13-817119 is hereby accepted by the Council of the City of Parma in the settlement amount of \$40,000.00.

Section 2. That the Law Director is hereby authorized to enter into said Agreement, and present said Agreement to the Cuyahoga County Common Pleas Court in settlement of the case known as Teresa Bryant, as Mother, Etc. vs. Police Officer James Manzo, Case No. CV-13-817119.

Section 3. That funds for said settlement shall be paid from Fund No. 605-605-Liability Insurance, Account No. 65319-03114-Claims Out.

Section 4. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements.

Section 5. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety, and welfare of the City of Parma, and for the further reason that this measure is necessary in order to resolve the pending lawsuit with the Defendants in the case known as Teresa Bryant, as Mother, Etc. vs. Police Officer James Manzo, Case No. CV-13-817119, and this Ordinance shall become immediately effective upon receiving the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all members elected to Council and approval of the Mayor, otherwise from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
