

ORDINANCE NO. 41-14

AN ORDINANCE TO REPEAL CHAPTERS 1545 “STEAM AND HOT WATER HEATING”; 1547 “PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS”; 1549 “CONTROLS”; 1551 “WARM AIR PIPING”; 1553 “WALL STACKS AND AIR SUPPLY”; 1555 “REFRIGERATION AND AIR-CONDITIONING”; AND 1557 “COMMERCIAL COOKING EQUIPMENT” OF TITLE FIVE “HEATING AND VENTILATING REGULATIONS” OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF PARMA, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the repeal of these Chapters of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Parma is necessary as they are in conflict with the Ohio Building Code;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PARMA, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That various Chapters of Title Five “Heating and Ventilating Regulations” of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Parma, as listed below, are hereby repealed in their entirety:

Chapter 1545	Steam and Hot Water Heating
Chapter 1547	Plans and Specifications
Chapter 1549	Controls
Chapter 1551	Warm Air Piping
Chapter 1553	Wall Stacks and Air Supply
Chapter 1555	Refrigeration and Air-Conditioning
Chapter 1557	Commercial Cooking Equipment

Section 2. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of the Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements.

Section 3. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety, and welfare of the City of Parma, and for the further reason that this measure is necessary as these Chapters are in conflict with the Ohio Building Code, and this Ordinance shall become immediately effective upon receiving the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all members elected to Council and approval of the Mayor, otherwise from and after the earliest period allowed by Law.
