AN ORDINANCE TO REPEAL SECTION 313.035 “USE OF AUTOMATED CAMERAS TO IMPOSE CIVIL PENALTIES UPON SPEEDING VIOLATORS IN ANY SCHOOL ZONE“ AND ENACT A NEW SECTION 313.035 AND TO REPEAL SECTION 313.13 “TRAFFIC LAW PHOTO-MONITORING DEVICES” OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF PARMA, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PARMA, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That Section 313.035 “Use of Automated Cameras to Impose Civil Penalties Upon Speeding Violators in any School Zone” of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Parma, as it existed heretofore, is hereby repealed in its entirety.

Section 2. That a new Section 313.035 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Parma, is hereby enacted to read as the attached Exhibit “A”.

Section 3. That Section 313.13 “Traffic Law Photo-Monitoring Devices” of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Parma, as it existed heretofore, is hereby repealed in its entirety.

Section 4. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of the Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements.

Section 5. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare of the City of Parma, and for the further reason that this measure is necessary in order to make these changes in the Codified Ordinances in the near future, and this Ordinance shall become immediately effective upon receiving the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all members elected to Council and approval of the Mayor, otherwise from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
