A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO APPLY TO THE TRANSPORTATION FOR LIVABLE COMMUNITIES INITIATIVE FOR A GRANT THROUGH THE NORTHEAST OHIO AREA WIDE COORDINATING AGENCY (NOACA), AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, this grant application will enable the City of Parma and its partner, the West Creek Conservancy, to seek funding for the study of the Quarry Creek District in the City of Parma; and,

WHEREAS, this study would evaluate and subsequently recommend transportation enhancements including but not limited to safety/functionality/pedestrian – bike usages, traffic patterns, parking lot retrofits/usage, policy, bike lanes, storm water control, aesthetics, and public art; and,

WHEREAS, this comprehensive study will enable the City of Parma and West Creek to plan for the redevelopment of this commercial and residential area and will enhance the viability of such;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PARMA, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the Mayor or his duly appointed representative is hereby approved to apply for a grant through the Northeast Ohio Area Wide Coordinating Agency (NOACA) for the Transportation for Livable Communities Initiative for the study of The Quarry Creek District in the City of Parma.

Section 2. That this Council hereby respectfully requests that the Northeast Ohio Areawide Coordinating Agency give favorable consideration to the City’s application for funding.

Section 3. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council; and that all deliberations of the Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements.

Section 4. That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety, and welfare of the City of Parma, and for the further reason that this measure is necessary due to the upcoming grant application deadline, and this Resolution shall become immediately effective upon receiving the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all members elected to Council and approval of the Mayor, otherwise from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
