AN ORDINANCE TO REPEAL ORDINANCE NO. 127-15 AND TO ENACT THIS NEW ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SERVICE TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT FOR PROFESSIONAL ENGINEERING, SURVEY, ENVIRONMENTAL AND GEOTECHNICAL SERVICES FOR THE CHEVROLET BOULEVARD AREA STORM AND SANITARY SEWERS IMPROVEMENT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 127-15 was adopted on June 15, 2015, but it did not have the required Board of Control meeting and authorization and this Agreement will need to be reintroduced and adopted by this Council after the meeting the Board of Control requirement;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PARMA, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That Ordinance No. 127-15 adopted on June 15, 2015, is hereby repealed in its entirety.

Section 2. That the Mayor and the Director of Public Service are hereby authorized to enter into an Agreement with Osborn Engineering for professional engineering, survey, environmental and geotechnical services for the Chevrolet Boulevard area storm and sanitary sewers improvement at a cost not to exceed \$88,700.00, with a copy of the proposal attached as Exhibit "A".

Section 3. That the Mayor and the Director of Public Service are hereby authorized to execute said Agreement and to take such action and to execute such other documents and amendments thereto as may be necessary as are approved by the Law Director.

Section 4. That funds for said services shall be paid from Fund No. 405-405-Capital Improvements; Account No. 62110-16215-Professional Services.

Section 5. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council; and that all deliberations of the Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements.

Section 6. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare of the City of Parma, and for the further reason that this measure is necessary in order to acquire federal funds in a timely fashion, and this Ordinance shall become immediately effective upon receiving the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all members elected to Council and approval of the Mayor, otherwise from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
