AN ORDINANCE TO AUTHORIZE THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SERVICE TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH A SUPPLIER FOR THE PROVISION OF ELECTRICITY FOR RESIDENTIAL CUSTOMERS THAT PARTICIPATE IN THE CITY OF PARMA ELECTRIC AGGREGATION PROGRAM, FOR THE PERIOD OF _____ TO _____, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PARMA, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the Director of Public Service be, and he hereby is, authorized to enter into a contract with _____ to act as the supplier for the provision of electricity for residential customers that participate in the City of Parma Electric Aggregation Program, for the period of _____, to _____ at the pricing set forth in Exhibit "A", which includes all program fees, except for contract modification pursuant to the requirements of Ohio Revised Code §735.07.

Section 2. That the Director of Public Service be, and he hereby is, authorized to execute said contract, and to take such action and to execute such other documents and amendments thereto as may be necessary as are approved by the Law Director.

Section 3. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council; and that all deliberations of the Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements.

Section 4. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare of the City of Parma, and for the further reason that this measure is necessary in order to have the supplier for the program which will begin in _____, and this Ordinance shall become immediately effective upon receiving the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all members elected to Council and approval of the Mayor, otherwise from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
