AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SUBSECTION (b) OF SECTION 351.12 “PARKING ON PRIVATE OR PUBLIC PROPERTY”, SUBSECTION (b)(2) OF SECTION 351.14 “PARKING OF RECREATIONAL VEHICLES”, SUBSECTION (b) OF SECTION 660.31 “VEHICLES”, AND SUBSECTION (b) OF SECTION 1707.15 “VEHICLES” OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF PARMA, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PARMA, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That a portion of subsection (b) of Section 351.12 “Parking on Private or Public Property” and a portion of subsection (b)(2) of Section 351.14 “Parking of Recreational Vehicles” of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Parma, which presently reads as follows:

“351.12 PARKING ON PRIVATE OR PUBLIC PROPERTY.

...

(b) No person shall park any licensed, operable motor vehicle, truck, motorcycle, trailer, bus or other vehicle or boat between the setback line and the public right-of-way, excluding the area approved by the Division of Buildings as a driveway and/or turnabout. Any of the above said vehicles parked on private property shall be parked on a hard surface driveway or turnabout or other hard surface parking area. Any collector’s vehicle, historical motor vehicle, junk motor vehicle or unregistered and/or inoperable vehicle shall be parked in a garage or other suitable structure as authorized by the codified ordinances of the City of Parma, consistent with all regulations where it is not visible from the street or other public or private property.”

“351.14 PARKING OF RECREATIONAL VEHICLES.

...

(b)... (2) If the camping and recreational equipment is parked or stored outside of a garage, it may be parked or stored anywhere upon a driveway or turnabout on the premises. The setback requirement in the side or rear yard shall be a minimum of three feet.”

is hereby amended to read as follows:

“351.12 PARKING ON PRIVATE OR PUBLIC PROPERTY.

...

(b) No person shall park any licensed, operable motor vehicle, truck, motorcycle, trailer, bus or other vehicle or boat between the **FRONT** setback line and the public right-of-way, excluding the area approved by the Division of Buildings as a driveway ~~and or turnabout.~~ ~~Any of the above said vehicles parked on private property shall be parked on a hard surface driveway or turnabout or other had surface parking area.~~ Any collector’s vehicle, historical motor vehicle,

junk motor vehicle or unregistered and/or inoperable vehicle shall be parked in a garage or other suitable structure as authorized by the codified ordinances of the City of Parma, consistent with all regulations where it is not visible from the street or other public or private property.”

“351.14 PARKING OF RECREATIONAL VEHICLES.

...

(b)...

(2) If the camping and recreational equipment is parked or stored outside of a garage, it may be parked or stored anywhere upon a driveway ~~or turnabout on the premises~~ **WHICH IS APPROVED BY THE DIVISION OF BUILDINGS**. The setback requirement in the side or rear yard shall be a minimum of three feet.”

Section 2. That a portion of subsection (b) of Section 660.31 “Vehicles” of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Parma, which presently reads as follows:

“660.31 Vehicles.

...

(b) No person shall park or leave any vehicle between the front setback line and the public right-of-way, excluding the area approved as a driveway and/or turnabout. Vehicles parked on private property shall be parked on a concrete driveway or turnabout or other approved hard-surface parking area.”

...

is hereby amended to read as follows:

“660.31 Vehicles.

...

(b) No person shall park or leave any vehicle between the front setback line and the public right-of-way, excluding the area approved **BY THE BUILDING COMMISSIONER** as a driveway.” ~~and/or turnabout. Vehicles parked on private property shall be parked on a concrete driveway or turnabout or other approved hard-surface parking area.~~

Section 3. That a portion of subsection (b) of Section 1707.15 “Vehicles” of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Parma, which presently reads as follows:

“1707.15 Vehicles.

...

(b) No person shall park or leave any vehicle between the front setback line and the public right-of-way, excluding the area approved by the Building Commissioner as a driveway and/or turnabout. Vehicles parked on private property shall be parked on a concrete driveway or turnabout or other hard-surface parking area approved by the Building Commissioner.”

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
