ORDINANCE NO. 213-16

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SERVICE TO ENTER INTO A MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN THE FIRE DEPARTMENTS OF THE FOLLOWING CITIES: PARMA, PARMA HEIGHTS, BROOKLYN AND BROOK PARK, IN CONJUNCTION WITH THE PARMA REGIONAL DISPATCH CENTER FOR THE ASSISTANCE TO FIREFIGHTERS GRANT ADMINISTERED THROUGH THE DEPARTMENT OF HOMELAND SECURITY, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the partners listed herein have agreed to enter into a collaborative agreement in which the City of Parma (Ohio) Fire Department will act in the capacity as the lead agency, named applicant and host city with the other agencies listed herein as partners in this application; and,

WHEREAS, the partners herein desire to enter into a Memorandum of Understanding setting forth the services to be provided by the collaborative and in conjunction with the Parma Regional Dispatch Center; and,

WHEREAS, each City will budget and provide financial support of ten percent (10%) of the total cost as outlined within the grant provisions, This amount shall not exceed Fourteen Thousand Dollars (\$14,000.00) for each station within their respective jurisdiction in which the system shall be installed;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PARMA, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the Director of Public Service is authorized to enter into a Memorandum of Understanding, with a copy of said Memorandum of Understanding in substantially similar form attached as Exhibit "A".

Section 2. That the Director of Public Service is hereby authorized to execute said Memorandum of Understanding and to take such action and to execute such other documents and amendments thereto as may be necessary as are approved by the Law Director.

Section 3. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council; and that all deliberations of the Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements.

Pg. 2 of L-213-16 Ord. to enter into a Memorandum of Understanding between the Fire Departments of the following Cities: Parma, Parma Heights, Brooklyn and Brook Park, in conjunction with the Parma Regional Dispatch Center for the Assistance to Firefighters Grant administered through the Department of Homeland Security.

Section 4. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare of the City of Parma, and for the further reason that this measure is necessary in order submit the application before the due date, and this Ordinance shall become immediately effective upon receiving the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all members elected to Council and approval of the Mayor, otherwise from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
