ORDINANCE NO. 108-16

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SAFETY TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT FOR THE PURCHASE OF TWO (2) 2016 CHEVROLET TAHOES FOR THE FIRE DEPARTMENT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PARMA, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the Director of Public Safety is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Tim Lally Chevrolet, Inc., for the purchase of two (2) Chevrolet Tahoes for the Fire Department, at a cost not to exceed \$65,500.00, with said price being below State bid pricing. The price includes the trade in of two (2) 2006 GMC Yukons.

Section 2. That the Director of Public Safety is hereby authorized to execute said contract and to take such action and to execute such other documents and amendments thereto as may be necessary as are approved by the Law Director.

Section 3. That it is found by this Council that the current equipment is unfit for public use and it further finds that the City has a need for other equipment of the same type, and that it is in the best interest of the City that such sale of obsolete equipment be made simultaneously with the purchase of the new equipment of the same type.

Section 4. That funds for said purchase shall be paid from Fund No. 105-105-Fire Levy; Account No. 68006-00000-Equipment & Facilities in the amount of \$32,500.00 and Fund No. 103-103-Paramedic Levy; Account No. 68006-00000-Equipment & Facilities in the amount of \$33,000.00.

Section 5. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements.

Section 6. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety, and welfare of the City of Parma, and for the further reason that this measure is necessary in order that the purchase can be made in the near future, and this Ordinance shall become immediately effective upon receiving the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all members elected to Council and approval of the Mayor, otherwise from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
