AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SAFETY TO ENTER INTO A RENEWAL LICENSE AGREEMENT WITH THE PARMA ANIMAL SHELTER, DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 289-03, adopted by City Council on June 7, 2004, authorized a License Agreement with the Parma Animal Shelter; and was renewed by Ordinance No. 136-06, adopted on June 6, 2005; and Ordinance No. 55-11, adopted on March 7, 2011;

WHEREAS, this Renewal License Agreement will be effective for five (5) years, March 16, 2016, through March 16, 2021;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PARMA, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the Director of Public Safety is hereby authorized to enter into a Renewal License Agreement with the Parma Animal Shelter, with a substantially similar copy of said Agreement attached hereto as Exhibit "A".

Section 2. That the Director of Public Safety is hereby authorized to execute said contract and to take such action and to execute such other documents and amendments thereto as may be necessary as are approved by the Law Director.

Section 3. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council; and that all deliberations of the Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements.

Section 4. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare of the City of Parma, and for the further reason that this measure is necessary in order for this Renewal License Agreement with the Parma Animal Shelter to be effective on March 16, 2016, and this Ordinance shall become immediately effective upon receiving the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all members elected to Council and approval of the Mayor, otherwise from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
