AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND A PORTION OF SUBSECTION (a) "STREETS AND PUBLIC SERVICES CODE" OF SECTION 185.05 "FEES OF THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SERVICE" OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF PARMA RELATIVE TO THE TELECOMMUNICATIONS RIGHT-OF-WAY PERMIT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PARMA, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That a portion of Subsection (a) "Streets and Public Services Code" of Section 185.05 "Fees of the Director of Public Service" of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Parma, which presently reads as follows:

"185.05 FEES OF THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SERVICE.
(a) Streets and Public Services Code.

...

Telecommunications right-of-way permit

Permit filing fee \$25.00 plus \$1.00 per linear foot of streets traversed, plus \$1,000.00 per underground street crossing, plus \$50,000 bond and insurance (to be held for one year after completion and approval of work)"

is hereby amended to read as follows:

"185.05 FEES OF THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SERVICE.
(a) Streets and Public Services Code.

...

Permit filing **Plan** ~~\$25.00~~ **\$300** ~~plus \$1.00 per linear foot of streets traversed, plus \$1,000.00 per underground street crossing, plus \$50,000 bond and insurance (to be held for one year after completion and approval of work)"~~

Permit Fee **\$500 annually per antenna or pole plus \$1 per linear foot of streets traversed plus \$1,000 per underground street crossing**

Section 2. That only that portion of subsection (a) "Streets and Public Services Code" of Section 185.05 "Fees of the Director of Public Service" of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Parma, as it existed heretofore, is hereby repealed.

Section 3. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of the Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements.

Section 4. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare of the City of Parma, and for the further reason that this measure is necessary in order to amend this section due to the upcoming expiration of the moratorium, and this Ordinance shall become immediately effective upon receiving the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all members elected to Council and approval of the Mayor, otherwise from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
