A RESOLUTION TO ESTABLISH THE SOLID WASTE
COLLECTION FEE FOR RESIDENTIAL ACCOUNTS FOR
YEAR 2017, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the City of Parma wishes to maintain the highest level of public services and public safety to City residents and faces continued elimination of the estate tax and prior reduction in the state/local government funds, both due to state legislative action; and,

WHEREAS, the collection and disposal of garbage and refuse in the City is a matter which affects the public health, welfare and safety of all City residents; and,

WHEREAS, Chapter 967 of the Codified Ordinances of the City provides for the establishment and collection of fees to be charged by the City for residential solid waste collection and disposal and recycling; and,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Parma, Cuyahoga County, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1. This City, through its Mayor and its Council, and in accordance with Chapter 967 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Parma, hereby determines to establish the fee for the cost and expense of solid waste collection and disposal and recycling for single-family and two-family residential properties within the City for the year 2017. The fee shall be twelve dollars (\$12.00) per month.

Section 2. That other qualified residential properties, as defined in Parma Codified Ordinance 967.03(c), shall be billed for the cost of pick-up and tonnage as set forth in the then current contract between the City of Parma and its residential solid waste collection, disposal and recycling services vendor, a copy of which is in the office of the Director of Public Service.

Section 3. That the amount of said solid waste collection and recycling fee for each dwelling unit shall be billed by the _____, for and on behalf of the City, to the owner and/or occupant of the residential property, in accordance with procedures established by the _____, and shall appear on the _____.

Section 4. This Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Resolution were taken in open meetings of this Council, and that all deliberations of the Council and of any committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with the law, including the City's Codified Ordinance and Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Res. to establish the Solid Waste Collection Fee for residential accounts for year 2017, and declaring an emergency

Section 5. This Resolution is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare of the City and for the further reason that this Resolution must be immediately effective to establish the fee for the year 2017 and to enable the City to receive the fee revenues to continue solid waste collection services in the City; provided this Resolution shall take effect and be in full force and effect from and immediately after its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in full force after the earlier period allowed by law.
