AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SERVICE TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT FOR PROFESSIONAL DESIGN SERVICES FOR THE W. RIDGEWOOD DRIVE RESURFACING AND REPAIR PROJECT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PARMA, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the Mayor and the Director of Public Service are hereby authorized to enter into a contract with GPD Group, for Professional Design Services for the W. Ridgewood Resurfacing and Repair Project at a cost not to exceed \$169,880.00.

Section 2. That the Mayor and the Director of Public Service are hereby authorized to execute said contract and to take such action and to execute such other documents and amendments thereto as may be necessary as are approved by the Law Director.

Section 3. That funds for said Professional Design Services shall be paid from Fund No. \_\_\_\_\_; Account No. \_\_\_\_\_.

Section 4. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council; and that all deliberations of the Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements.

Section 5. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare of the City of Parma, and for the further reason that this service is necessary in order to enter into the contract in the near future, and this Ordinance shall become immediately effective upon receiving the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all members elected to Council and approval of the Mayor, otherwise from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
