HOUSING ORDINANCE NO. 19-10

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND A PORTION OF SECTION 3 OF HOUSING ORDINANCE NO. 18-4 RELATIVE TO THE CONTRACT WITH THE LAW FIRM OF BROUSE MCDOWELL FOR LEGAL SERVICES FOR THE PARMA PUBLIC HOUSING AGENCY, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PARMA, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That Section 3 of Housing Ordinance No. 18-4, passed on June 17, 2019, which presently reads as follows:

“Section 3. That funds for said services shall be paid from Fund No. 270-270-Parma Public Housing HUD; Account No. 62110-01804-Professional Services, and a separate line item shall be created to maintain these funds solely for this purpose.”

is hereby amended to read as follows:

“Section 3. That funds for said services shall be paid from the PNC Bank Account used for the operation of the Low Rent Public Housing. A separate expenditure line item shall be created in the agency accounting records to track and identify these expenses.”

Section 2. That Section 3 of Housing Ordinance No. 18-4, passed on June 17, 2019, as it existed heretofore, is hereby repealed.

Section 3. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements.

Section 4. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety, and welfare of the City of Parma, and for the further reason that this measure is necessary in order to begin the legal assistance required by the Agency, and this Ordinance shall become immediately effective upon receiving the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all members elected to Council and approval of the Mayor, otherwise from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
