AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SERVICE TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH GARDINER FOR REPAIRS AT THE MICHAEL A. RIES ICE RINK FOR CHILLER PROJECT REPAIRS TO TWO (2) CHILLING TOWERS AT THE STATE BID AMOUNT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PARMA, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the Director of Public Service is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Gardiner at the State bid amount of \$159,935.00 for repairs to two (2) chilling towers at the Michael A. Ries Ice Rink. National IPA CPN Quote #R150505-OH-19983. A copy of said contract is attached in substantially similar form as Exhibit "A".

Section 2. That the Director of Public Service is hereby authorized to execute said agreement and to take such action and to execute such other documents and amendments thereto as may be necessary as are approved by the Law Director.

Section 3. That funds for said purchase shall be paid from Fund No. 405-405 - Capital Improvements and Fund No. 118-118 – First Energy Efficient Grant Fund; Account No. 62110-10119 - Professional Services.

Section 4. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements.

Section 5. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety, and welfare of the City of Parma, and for the further reason that this measure is necessary in order for the ice rink to operate properly, and this Ordinance shall become immediately effective upon receiving the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all members elected to Council and approval of the Mayor, otherwise from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
