AN ORDINANCE REQUESTING AND
AUTHORIZING THE CUYAHOGA COUNTY
FISCAL OFFICER TO MAKE TAX ADVANCES
TO CERTAIN DESIGNATED OFFICERS OF
THE CITY OF PARMA, AND DECLARING AN
EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PARMA, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the Cuyahoga County Fiscal Officer be, and he hereby is, respectfully requested and authorized to pay the Treasurer and/or Auditor of the City of Parma, upon request by either or both of them, any tax receipts available from the collection of taxes for the year 2019, collected in 2020, or any part thereof, at any time, either at or before final settlement is made for any tax collection period.

Section 2. That the Treasurer and/or Auditor of the City of Parma is/are authorized to sign the necessary documents to secure such advances and also the secondary documents to secure the semiannual settlement with the County Treasurer during the calendar year 2019.

Section 3. That the authorization herein conferred shall extend to any advances that may be requested during the calendar year 2020.

Section 4. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements.

Section 5. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety, and welfare of the City of Parma, and for the further reason that this measure is necessary in order to continue to collect future property tax revenues on a timely basis, and this Ordinance shall become immediately effective upon receiving the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all members elected to Council and approval of the Mayor, otherwise from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
