

RESOLUTION NO. 95-19

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE AUDITOR TO ACCEPT THE DONATION OF CURRENT SICK LEAVE ACCUMULATION INTO THE SICK LEAVE ACCOUNT OF JOSEPH FLORCZYK IN ORDER TO CONTINUE HIS PAYROLL WHILE HE IS OFF WORK DUE TO AN ILLNESS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Fraternal Order of Police, Lodge 15 (Corrections Officers Unit), has notified the City of an interest in donating accumulated sick leave time for Joseph Florczyk while he is off work due to an illness; and,

WHEREAS, such procedure is not covered in the Collective Bargaining Agreement of the unit; and,

WHEREAS, the initial Resolution No. 224-18 offering sick time donations for Joseph Florczyk expired on February 11, 2019. A second Resolution offering sick time donations for Joseph Florczyk was adopted on February 4, 2019 and will expire on May 13, 2019;

NOW, THEREFORE; BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PARMA, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That this Council of the City of Parma hereby authorizes the Auditor to accept donations of current sick leave accumulations for Joseph Florczyk in order to continue his payroll, while he is off work due to an illness.

Section 2. That the Auditor shall be authorized to accept current sick leave accumulations for a period of ninety (90) days commencing on May 14, 2019, unless extended by this Council.

Section 3. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements.

Section 4. That this Resolution is hereby required to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare of the City of Parma, and for the further reason that this measure is necessary in order to continue this employee’s medical benefits and payroll while he is off work due to an illness, and this Resolution shall become immediately effective upon receiving the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all members elected to Council and approval of the Mayor, otherwise from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
