

HOUSING ORDINANCE NO. 20-6

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC HOUSING TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT FOR FEE ACCOUNTING SERVICES TO THE PARMA PUBLIC HOUSING AGENCY, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PARMA, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the Director of Public Housing is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Salvatore Consiglio, CPA, to provide fee accounting services to the Parma Public Housing Agency for the period beginning January 1, 2021, and ending December 31, 2023, with three (3) one-year options for a total period through December 31, 2025, at the cost not to exceed \$29,700.00 per year (no increase in fees in any contract year).

Section 2. That the Director of Public Housing is hereby authorized to execute said contract and to take such action and to execute such other documents and amendments thereto as may be necessary as are approved by the Law Director.

Section 3. That funds for said contract shall be paid from Fund No. 270-270-Parma Public Housing-HUD, Account No. 62110-00000-Professional Services.

Section 4. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements.

Section 5. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare of the City of Parma, and for the further reason that this measure is necessary to ensure there is no gap in current fee accounting services being received, and this Ordinance shall become immediately effective upon receiving the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all members elected to Council and approval of the Mayor, otherwise from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
