

ORDINANCE NO. 166-21

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SAFETY TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH STEPHEN CAMPBELL ASSOCIATES (SCA), SOLE SOURCE PROVIDER FOR THE PURCHASE OF AN EVENTIDE NEXLOG 740 RECORDING SYSTEM AND APPLICATION SOFTWARE FOR THE COMMUNICATIONS CENTER, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, Ordinance No.105-21, adopted on August 2, 2021 authorized this purchase, however the Board of Control procedure was never completed, therefore, this new Ordinance will require the Board of Control for the purchase.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PARMA, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the Mayor and the Director of Public Safety are hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Stephen Campbell Associates (SCA), sole source provider, for the purchase of an Eventide Nexlog 740 Recording System and Application Software at a cost of \$94,213.00 with 60% reimbursement from the Ohio 9-1-1 Local Subgrant.

Section 2. That the Mayor and the Director of Public Safety are hereby authorized to execute said contract and to take such action and to execute such other documents and amendments thereto as may be necessary as are approved by the Law Director.

Section 3. That funds for said purchase shall be paid from Fund No.001-017 – General Fund – Communication Center; Account No. 68006-00000 – Equipment and Facilities; and Fund No. 423-423 – Communication Center – Ridge Rd.; Account No. 68006 – 00000 – Equipment and Facilities.

Section 4. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council; and that all deliberations of the Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements.

Section 5. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare of the City of Parma, and for the further reason that this is necessary in order to enter into the contract in the near future, and this Ordinance shall become immediately effective upon receiving the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all members elected to Council and approval of the Mayor, otherwise from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
