ORDINANCE NO. 106-22

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION 1 OF ORDINANCE NO. 41-21, FOR THE CONTRACT WITH CDW GOVERNMENT LLC, FOR CONSULTING SERVICES FOR THE BUILDING AND ENGINEERING DEPARTMENTS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PARMA, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That Section 1 of Ordinance No. 41-21, passed on May 17, 2021, which presently reads as follows:

“Section 1. That the Mayor and/or the Safety Director are authorized to enter into a contract with CDW Government LLC, for consulting services for the Building and Engineering Departments in the amount not to exceed \$62,000.00, with a copy of said contract, in substantially similar form attached as Exhibit “A”.

is hereby amended to read as follows:

“Section 1. That the Mayor and/or the Safety Director are authorized to enter into a contract with CDW Government LLC, for consulting services for the Building and Engineering Departments in the amount not to exceed ~~\$62,000.00~~ **\$102,000.00**, with a copy of said contract, in substantially similar form attached as Exhibit “A”.

Section 2. That Section 1 of Ordinance No. 41-21, passed May 17, 2021, as it existed heretofore, is hereby repealed.

Section 3. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements.

Section 4. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety, and welfare of the City of Parma, and for the further reason that this measure is necessary in order to amend the dollar amount, and this Ordinance shall become immediately effective upon receiving the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all members elected to Council and approval of the Mayor, otherwise from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
