

ORDINANCE NO. 101-23

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SAFETY TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH THE LOWEST AND BEST BIDDER FOR A NEW TELEPHONE SYSTEM FOR THE PARMA JUSTICE CENTER IN THE CITY OF PARMA, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PARMA, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the Director of Public Safety is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with _____, the lowest and best bidder, for the purchase of a new telephone system, at the bid price of \$_____, except for contract modifications pursuant to the requirements of Ohio Revised Code §735.07.

Section 2. That the Director of Public Safety is hereby authorized to execute said contract and to take such action and to execute such other documents and amendments thereto as may be necessary as are approved by the Law Director.

Section 3. That funds for said purchase shall be paid from Fund No. 405-405 – Capital Improvements; Account No. 68006 – 00011 – Equipment and Facilities; Fund No.167-167 – Court Facilities; Account No. 62110-00000 – Professional Services; and Fund No. 167-167 – Court Facilities; Account No. 68006 – 00000 – Equipment and Facilities

Section 4. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council; and that all deliberations of the Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements.

Section 5. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare of the City of Parma, and for the further reason that this measure is necessary in order to purchase the new telephone system as soon as possible, and this Ordinance shall become immediately effective upon receiving the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all members elected to Council and approval of the Mayor, otherwise from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
