AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SAFETY TO ENTER INTO A FIVE (5) YEAR MAINTENANCE CONTRACT WITH STRYKER FOR AMBULANCE COTS FOR THE PARMA FIRE DEPARTMENT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PARMA, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the Director of Public Safety is hereby authorized to enter into a five (5) year Maintenance Contract with Stryker for ambulance cots for the Parma Fire Department at a cost not to exceed \$97,059.90, with a copy of said Contract attached as Exhibit "A".

Section 2. That the Director of Public Safety is hereby authorized to execute said Contract and to take such action and to execute such other documents and amendments thereto as may be necessary and as are approved by the Law Director.

Section 3. That funds for said services shall be paid from Fund Nos. 103-103 – EMS Billing; Account No. 62110-00000-Professional Services.

Section 4. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council; and that all deliberations of the Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements.

Section 5. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare of the City of Parma, and for further reason that the ambulance cots are in need of servicing as soon as possible, and this Ordinance shall become immediately effective upon receiving the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all members elected to Council and approval of the Mayor, otherwise from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
