AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SERVICE TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH SNIDER RECREATION, INC., FOR THE PURCHASE AND INSTALLATION OF PLAYGROUND EQUIPMENT FOR HETZEL PARK, JOHN PETRUSKA PARK, AND WALTER’S GROVE PARK AT STATE BID PRICING, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PARMA, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the Director of Public Service is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Snider Recreation, Inc., for the purchase and installation of playground equipment for Hetzel Park (\$43,046.00), John Petruska Park (\$38,249.00), and Walter’s Grove Park (\$44,498.00), for a total amount of \$131,475.00, at Ohio STS Pricing, Contract No. 011008 through a Grant Agreement with the Ohio Department of Natural Resources for the Capital Improvement Community Park Recreation/Conservation Project.

Section 2. That the Director of Public Service is hereby authorized to execute said contract and to take such action and to execute such other documents and amendments thereto as may be necessary and as are approved by the Law Director.

Section 3. That the balance of funds for said purchase shall be paid from Fund No. 405-405 – Capital Improvements; Account No. 62110-00000-Professional Services.

Section 4. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements.

Section 5. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety, and welfare of the City of Parma, and for the further reason that this measure is necessary in order to secure the playground equipment as soon as possible, and this Ordinance shall become immediately effective upon receiving the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all members elected to Council and approval of the Mayor, otherwise from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
