ORDINANCE NO. 191-23

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND/OR THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SAFETY TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT TO PURCHASE A NEW 2028 MONARCH SUTPHEN PUMPER FIRE ENGINE TO REPLACE AN AGING UNIT FOR THE PARMA FIRE DEPARTMENT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PARMA, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the Mayor and/or Director of Public Safety are hereby authorized to enter into a contract with _____ for the purchase of one (1) 2028 Monarch Sutphen Pumper Fire Engine for the Parma Fire Department at a cost not to exceed \$_____, under the State of Ohio Procurement Pricing (ID Number _____).

Section 2. That the Mayor and/or Director of Public Safety are hereby authorized to execute said contract and to take such action and to execute such other documents and amendments thereto as may be necessary as are approved by the Law Director.

Section 3. That funds for said purchase shall be paid from Fund and Account numbers in Future Appropriations.

Section 4. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements.

Section 5. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety, and welfare of the City of Parma, and for the further reason that this measure is necessary in order to replace an aging (1996) fire engine that is beyond its useful life and there is a 2-3 year lead time to receive the new fire engine, and this Ordinance shall become immediately effective upon receiving the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all members elected to Council and approval of the Mayor, otherwise from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
