AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT OF COOPERATION BETWEEN CUYAHOGA COUNTY AND THE CITY OF PARMA FOR THE REPLACEMENT OF THE RIDGEWOOD DRIVE BRIDGE NO. 03.50 OVER WEST CREEK (LOCATED WEST OF BROADVIEW ROAD) IN THE CITY OF PARMA, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, The City of Parma has recognized the need for and proposes the improvement of a portion of a public highway; and

WHEREAS, the bridge over Ridgewood Drive No. 03.50 over West Creek (West of Broadview Road) is a County Route and therefore is inspected and maintained by the County; and

WHEREAS, the City of Parma will cooperate with Cuyahoga County in the replacement of Ridgewood Drive Bridge No. 03.50 over West Creek in the City; and

WHEREAS, allocation from the County Motor Vehicle License Tax Fund will be the financial source for this project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PARMA, STATE OF OHIO:

- Section 1. That the Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to enter into an Agreement of Cooperation with Cuyahoga County, with a copy of said Agreement in substantially similar form attached as Exhibit "A".
- Section 2. That the Mayor is hereby authorized to execute amendments to said agreement as may be necessary, and to take such action and to execute such other documents as necessary in connection therewith, as are approved by the Law Director.
- Section 3. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council; and that all deliberations of the Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements.
- Section 4. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare of the City of Parma, and for the further reason that this measure is necessary in order for the City to give consent to the County to participate in the cost of construction of the above described improvement, and this Ordinance shall become immediately effective upon receiving the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all members elected to Council and approval of the Mayor, otherwise from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
