A RESOLUTION OBJECTING TO THE APPLICATION OF A LIQUOR PERMIT FOR FAMILY DOLLAR, 5445 RIDGE ROAD IN PARMA, OHIO, A LOCATION THAT IS A DRY PRECINCT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, that Family Dollar, located at 5445 Ridge Road in Parma, Ohio is located in a dry precinct; and

WHEREAS, it was verified with the Cuyahoga County Board of Elections that the precinct that Family Dollar is located, was voted as a dry precinct in 1991 and it has not been overturned to date.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PARMA, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That this Council of the City of Parma hereby objects to the issuance of a liquor permit to Family Dollar located at 5445 Ridge Road in the City of Parma.

Section 2. That the Clerk of Council is hereby authorized and directed to forward a certified copy of this Resolution to the Ohio Department of Liquor Control.

Section 3. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of the Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements.

Section 4. That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety, and welfare of the City of Parma, and for the further reason that this business is located in a dry precinct, and this Resolution shall become immediately effective upon receiving the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all members elected to Council and approval of the Mayor, otherwise from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
