AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO APPLY FOR, ACCEPT, AND ENTER INTO A WATER POLLUTION CONTROL LOAN FUND (WPCLF) AGREEMENT ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF PARMA FOR PLANNING AND DESIGN OF THE NORTH/WEST LINDEN LANE SEPTIC ABATEMENT PROJECT - PHASE ONE, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the City of Parma seeks to upgrade its existing wastewater facilities; and

WHEREAS, the City of Parma desires to apply for a loan through the WPCLF for the planning and design of the North/West Linden Lane Septic Abatement Project and related improvements to its wastewater facilities; and

WHEREAS, the Ohio Water Pollution Control Loan Fund (WPCLF) requires the government authority to pass legislation for the application of a loan, and the execution of an agreement, as well as designating a dedication repayment source.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PARMA, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the City of Parma is hereby authorized to apply for a WPCLF loan, sign all documents for, and enter into an agreement with Ohio Environmental Protection Agency and the Ohio Water Development Authority for the planning and design of wastewater facilities on behalf of the City of Parma, Ohio.

Section 2. That the dedicated source of repayment will be Parma Capital Improvement. Upon reimbursement from the WPCLF, the loan proceeds shall be deposited into Fund No. 478-478- North/West Linden Lane Septic Abatement Program; Fund No. 62110-00000–Professional Services.

Section 3. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare of the City of Parma, and for the further reason that this measure is necessary in order to comply with the funding agency application deadline, and this Ordinance shall become immediately effective upon receiving the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all members elected to Council and approval of the Mayor, otherwise from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
