A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING "WORLD OVARIAN CANCER DAY" ON MAY 8, 2024, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, World Ovarian Cancer Day was established in the year 2013 by ovarian cancer advocacy organizations from around the world; and

WHEREAS, ovarian cancer is the 8th most common cancer in women in the world and there are more than 30 different types of ovarian cancer; and

WHEREAS, ovarian cancer is the 8^{th} most common cause of death from cancer among women in the world; and

WHEREAS, approximately 324,000 women are diagnosed with ovarian cancer and approximately 207,000 women die with this disease globally every year; and

WHEREAS, by the year 2050, the number of women diagnosed with ovarian cancer is projected to increase over 55% to 503,448; and

WHEREAS, people around the world come together to support the work the organizations do in helping to promote ovarian cancer awareness by acknowledging May 8, 2024, as "World Ovarian Cancer Day."

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PARMA, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That this Council hereby advocates May 8, 2024, as "World Ovarian Cancer Day".

Section 2. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements.

Section 3. That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare of the City of Parma, and for the further reason that this measure is necessary due to the observance taking place this month, and this Resolution shall become immediately effective upon receiving the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all members elected to Council and approval of the Mayor, otherwise from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
