

ORDINANCE NO. 30-16

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SERVICE TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH THE BEST BIDDER FOR THE PURCHASE OF A PYROTECHNICS DISPLAY INCLUDING A LICENSED PYROTECHNIST AND QUALIFIED ASSISTANTS FOR THE CITY OF PARMA'S JULY 4, 2016, FIREWORKS DISPLAY, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PARMA, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the Mayor and the Director of Public Service of the City of Parma be, and they hereby are, authorized and directed to enter into an agreement with _____, the best bidder, to provide a pyrotechnics display including the furnishing of a licensed pyrotechnist and qualified assistants as provided and in the amount within their proposal for the City of Parma's July 4, 2016, fireworks display, consistent with the requirements of the applicable Codified Ordinances of the City of Parma, at a bid price not to exceed \$40,000.00.

Section 2. That the Mayor and the Director of Public Service be, and they hereby are, authorized to execute said contract and to take such action and to execute such other documents and amendments thereto as may be necessary as are approved by the Law Director.

Section 3. That funds for said pyrotechnics display, pyrotechnist, and assistants shall be paid from Fund No. 286-286-Special Recreation, Account No. 62110-03016-Professional Services.

Section 4. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements.

Section 5. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare of the City of Parma, and for the further reason that this measure is necessary in order to have the contract awarded for the July 4, 2016 festivities, and this Ordinance shall become immediately effective upon receiving the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all members elected to Council and approval of the Mayor, otherwise from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
