

ORDINANCE NO. 113-14

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SAFETY TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT FOR THE PURCHASE OF TWO (2) POWER LOADERS UNDER THE STATE OF OHIO PROCUREMENT PRICING FOR THE PARMA FIRE DEPARTMENT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PARMA, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the Director of Public Safety is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Penn Care Public Safety Technology for the purchase of two (2) Power Loaders (used to put cots into the ambulance) for the Parma Fire Department at a cost not to exceed \$55,000.00, under the State of Ohio Procurement Pricing. The amount of \$40,000.00 will be paid by a grant awarded to the Parma Fire Department by the Bureau of Workers Compensation.

Section 2. That the Director of Public Safety is hereby authorized to execute said agreement and to take such action and to execute such other documents and amendments thereto as may be necessary as are approved by the Law Director.

Section 3. That remaining funds in the amount of \$15,000.00 for said purchase shall be paid from Fund No. 615-615-Bureau of Workers Compensation; Account No. 68006-00000-Equipment and Facilities.

Section 4. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements.

Section 5. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety, and welfare of the City of Parma, and for the further reason that this measure is necessary in order to have this equipment in the near future to comply with the terms of the grant, and this Ordinance shall become immediately effective upon receiving the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all members elected to Council and approval of the Mayor, otherwise from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
