



Attention Owners:

New HUD regulation for HQS Inspections

The Department of Housing & Urban Development (HUD) has updated the requirements for all subsidized units being supported by the Housing Choice Voucher (Section 8 Program).

- Carbon monoxide detectors **WILL** be required within 10 feet outside any bedroom or any area used as a sleeping area within the unit.
- Non-compliance will be considered an emergency failure, just like non-working smoke detectors.
- Effective Dec. 27, 2022, we will begin inspecting all units for compliance.
