

City of Parma 2022 Leaf Collection Schedule

Notice to Residents

The leaf collection program helps prevent blockage of street catch basins, sewer backup into homes and standing water in the roadways that can cause icy conditions. The City of Parma's leaf collection program is not intended to be a landscaping service for its residents, and residents should limit their leaf collections from their front yards. Residents should follow some basic instructions:

1. Do not rake leaves into the street and avoid blocking catch basins. Do not put sticks, rocks or other debris into the leaf piles, which may cause damage to leaf equipment or cause injury to city workers.
2. Do not park vehicles on the street in front of leaf piles during a scheduled collection week because this may hinder the collection process.
3. During their scheduled times, residents should have their leaves ready for pickup on tree lawns. If that is not possible, it is the resident's responsibility to bag leaves according to Rumpke guidelines and put them out on the scheduled trash pickup day.
4. The exact dates or times streets will be serviced is difficult to predict, but weather permitting, the below schedule will indicate the dates and times in four sections. For more information, contact the Service Department at 440-885-8980 or 440-885-8191.

Section 1

From Brookpark/West 54th (east side of street) to W. 10th and
from W. 10th/Brookpark (south) to Ridgewood (north side of street)

October 31 – November 4

November 28 – December 2

Section 2

From Ridge/Ridgewood (south) to Sprague Road and from Sprague Road to W. 130th

November 7 – November 11

December 5 – December 9

Section 3

From Ridge/Ridgewood (south side of street) to Broadview and
from Broadview/Ridgewood (south) to Sprague Road

November 14 – November 18

December 12 – December 16

Section 4

From Brookpark/W. 130th (east) to W. 54th (west side of street) and
from W. 54th/Brookpark (south) to Ridgewood (west) to Westminster

November 21 – November 25

December 19 – December 23
