A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC HOUSING TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT TO RENEW THE SOFTWARE SUPPORT AGREEMENT WITH MRI SOFTWARE LLC., AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, this is a continuation of a previous contract with HAPPY Software, which has since been acquired by MRI Software;

WHEREAS, a new Order Document, effective January 1, 2023 shall be added to the Original Order Document.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PARMA, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the Director of Public Housing is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement to renew the software support agreement with MRI Software LLC., for one additional year (starting January 1, 2023), at the cost not to exceed \$24,460.32. This agreement will allow Parma Public Housing to process all Housing Choice Voucher Program participants and applicants, in an efficient manner.

Section 2. That the Director of Public Housing is hereby authorized to execute said contract and to take such action and to execute such other documents and amendments thereto as may be necessary as are approved by the Law Director.

Section 3. That funds for said contract shall be paid from Fund No. 270-270-Parma Public Housing-HUD, Account No. 68006-00000-Equipment & Facilities.

Section 4. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements.

Section 5. That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare of the City of Parma, and for the further reason that this measure is necessary to renew the software support agreement to enable the PPHA to process all required program reporting to be in compliance with all HUD reporting, and this Resolution shall become immediately effective upon receiving the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all members elected to Council and approval of the Mayor, otherwise from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
