

RESOLUTION NO. 5-23

A RESOLUTION URGING THE FEDERAL GOVERNMENT TO MAKE REPAIRS TO THE PARMA POST OFFICE AT 7801 DAY DRIVE, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Parma Post Office located at 7801 Day Drive is in need of numerous repairs; and

WHEREAS, the American flag flying at this location is not properly illuminated and according to the US flag code, "It should be illuminated if displayed at night."; and

WHEREAS, an exterior lamp that was damaged several months ago has yet to be repaired, and the exterior of the building, both front and back, are not sufficiently lit during the evening hours creating a potential safety hazard; and

WHEREAS, the parking lot is full of potholes subjecting customers to walk on uneven ground while conducting their post office business; and

WHEREAS, the interior flooring is also in disarray; and

WHEREAS, the City of Parma is proud to boast two (2) post offices within the city limits, and it is the Council and Administration's hope that the Federal Government will make these repairs as soon as possible for our residents and visitors.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PARMA, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the Council and the Administration of the City of Parma hereby urge the Federal Government to make repairs to the post office located at 7801 Day Drive in Parma, Ohio.

Section 2. That the Clerk of Council is hereby directed to forward a true and accurate copy of this Resolution to Postmaster General Louis DeJoy, Postmaster of 7801 Day Drive Branch Rose Spraggins, United States Senator Sherrod Brown, United States Senator J.D. Vance, and State Representative Max Miller.

Section 3. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements.

Section 4. That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare of the City of Parma, and for the further reason that this Council wants to urge the federal government to make these repairs as soon as possible, and this Resolution shall become immediately effective upon receiving the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all members elected to Council and approval of the Mayor, otherwise from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
